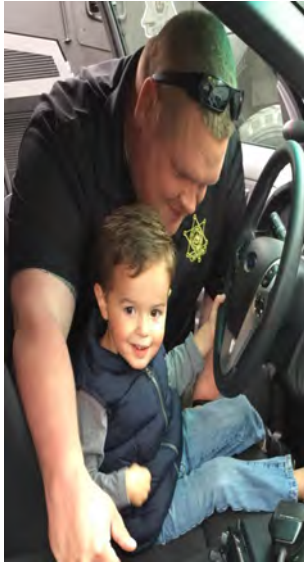

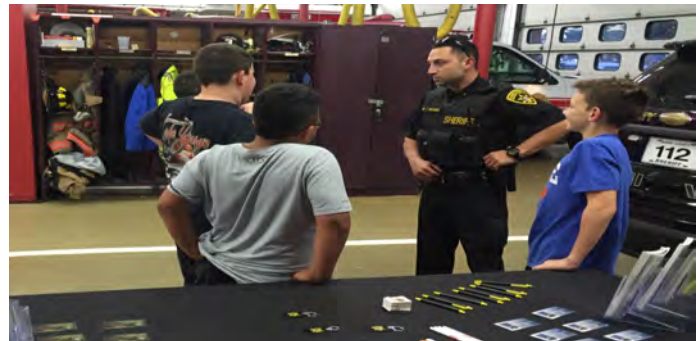
Coffee With a Cop Day

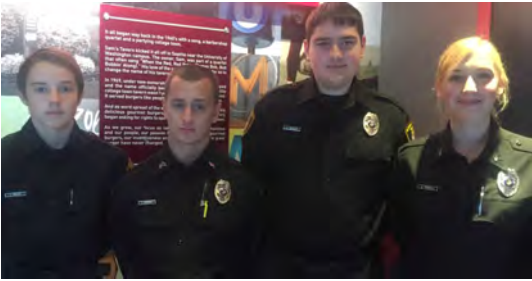


2016 Fire Prevention Week

Tip-A-Cop Event



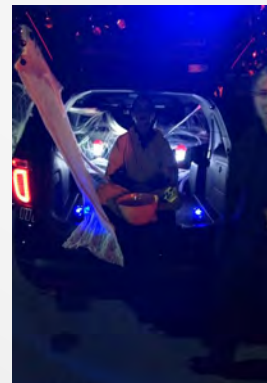
