The mission of the Albany County Coroners is to investigate deaths which occur in a non-medical setting or which are suspicious in nature. The Coroners expeditiously investigate and record fatalities and assist survivors who are grieving or experiencing trauma as a result of the death of a loved one.

ABOUT OUR DEPARTMENT

The four elected Coroners must maintain complete and accurate records of all cases and provide timely information and copies of reports to next of kin. In addition, the Coroners provide reports to appropriate agencies in cases involving children, prisoners and mental health patients. Services are provided 24-hours per day, seven days a week, year round.

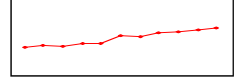
OUTCOMES

DEPARTMENT HIGHLIGHT

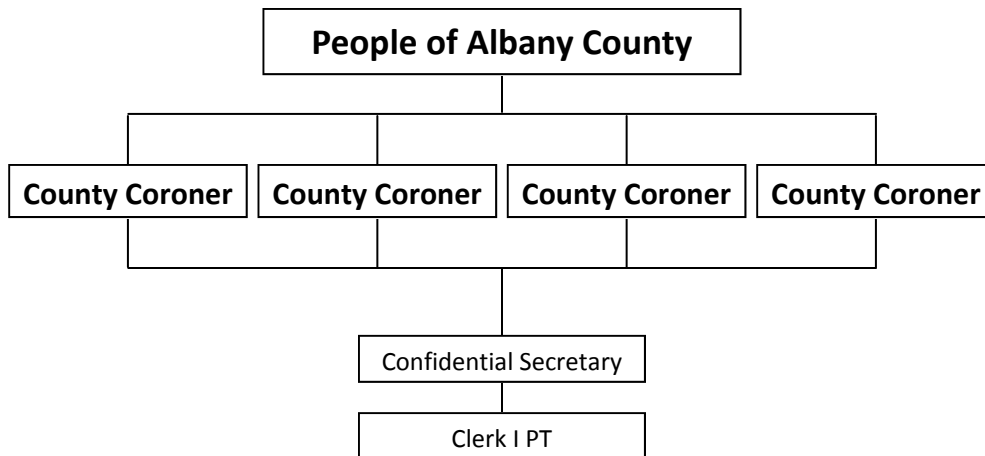
The Executive Budget proposes appropriations based on current expenditure patterns.
