

RESOLUTION NO. 91

APPROVING THE COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT WITH ALBANY COUNTY DSS/DCYFS UNIT

WHEREAS, The County of Albany and the Albany County DSS/DCYS Units Local 801 of the Civil Service Employees Association, Inc. Local 1000, AFSCME, AFL-CIO have been negotiating a contract for those employees of the County Departments represented by said unit, and the terms and conditions of employment have been agreed upon, and

WHEREAS, Under terms of the agreement, employees of the bargaining unit will receive a retroactive 3% raise to January 1, 2006; a 3% raise effective January 1, 2007, a 2% pay raise effective January 1, 2008, followed by another 2% raise on July 1, 2008, plus increases in longevity payments after 12 years of service, and

WHEREAS, The agreement also allows employees who have accumulated a minimum of six weeks of vacation to sell back one week of vacation accruals, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the portions of said agreement for the term of January 1, 2006 through December 31, 2008 setting forth salary and benefit provisions for members of the bargaining unit in the Albany County Department of Social Services and the Albany County Department for Children, Youth and Families are ratified and confirmed, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the 2007 Department of Social Services and the Department for Children, Youth and Families Budgets are amended to accommodate said agreements as indicated in a spreadsheet filed with the Clerk of the Legislature, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
