

RESOLUTION NO. 105

AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 383 FOR 2006: ADDITIONAL FUNDING REGARDING THE YOUTH TOBACCO ENFORCEMENT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, By Resolution No. 383 for 2006, this Honorable Body authorized an agreement with the New York State Department of Health regarding the enforcement provisions of the Adolescent Tobacco Use Prevention Act for the prevention of tobacco use by youth and pregnant women, and

WHEREAS, The program requires the County Health Department to establish and maintain an up-to-date inventory of all registered and unregistered tobacco retailers, vendors and vending machines in the County; complete compliance checks with underage youth of all retail tobacco vendors; identify unlicensed vendors and report them to the State Health Department; coordinate training of tobacco vendors; and report and track tobacco inspections and violations to the State Health Department, and

WHEREAS, The Department of Health has been notified by the NYS Department of Health that it will receive an additional \$1,623.29 in Cost of Living Adjustments for the youth tobacco enforcement program for the period beginning October 1, 2006 through September 30, 2007, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that Resolution No. 383 for 2006 is amended to indicate that the fee corresponding to the youth tobacco grant for the period beginning October 1, 2006 through September 30, 2007 is changed to read \$117,572.29 rather than \$115,949, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
