

**RESOLUTION NO. 144**

**AUTHORIZING AGREEMENTS WITH THE TOWN OF NEW SCOTLAND AND THE DELMAR FIRE DISTRICT REGARDING EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIANS - DEFIBRILLATION (EMT-D) AND AMENDING THE 2007 SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT BUDGET**

By Public Safety Committee, Messrs. Reilly and Domalewicz:

WHEREAS, The Albany County Sheriff has requested authorization to enter into agreements with the Town of New Scotland and the Delmar Fire District to provide Emergency Medical Technicians-Defibrillation (EMT-D), and

WHEREAS, Albany County will provide the Town of New Scotland with one EMT-D and the Delmar Fire District with two EMT-Ds and an additional part-time EMT-D and in return the Town of New Scotland and the Delmar Fire District will reimburse the County for said services, and

WHEREAS, The Sheriff further has requested a budget amendment to reflect the addition of the part-time EMT-D providing coverage six hours a day, seven days a week to the Delmar Fire District, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into agreements with the Town of New Scotland and the Delmar Fire District for the period January 1, 2007 through December 31, 2007 regarding Emergency Medical Technicians – Defibrillation (EMT-D), and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the agreement with the Town of New Scotland shall be for the amount of \$39,990.54 and the Delmar Fire District for the amount of \$116,703.74, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the 2007 Sheriff's Department Budget is amended as follows:

Increase Revenue Account A2265 Advanced Life Support by \$21,694

Increase Appropriation Account A3110.1 by \$21,694 by increasing Line Item A3310 1 9944 000 Emergency Medical Techn. PT by \$21,694

and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreements as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
