

RESOLUTION NO. 172

**AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE
NYS DIVISION OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE SERVICES REGARDING THE
2007 STOP VIOLENCE AGAINST WOMEN GRANT**

WHEREAS, The Director of the Crime Victim and Sexual Violence Center has indicated that grant funding in the amount of \$20,000 is available to Albany County through the NYS Division of Criminal Justice Services regarding the STOP Violence Against Women Grant, and

WHEREAS, The Director indicated that the STOP Violence Against Women Grant would be used to design and implement an on-line training curriculum for volunteers who provide hotline services and accompaniments to the emergency room, police station and court for crime victims, and

WHEREAS, The Director further indicated that the program will also explore the potential replacement of the current data base which would allow for the unified data collection for both sexual assault and domestic violence victims, and

WHEREAS, The Director has requested authorization to submit a grant application to the NYS Division of Criminal Justice Services regarding the STOP Violence Against Women Grant in the amount of \$20,000, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to submit a grant application to the NYS Division of Criminal Justice Services pertaining to the STOP Violence Against Women Grant in the amount of \$20,000, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said grant application as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
