

RESOLUTION NO. 180

AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH CALLANAN INDUSTRIES REGARDING THE HAULING AND PLACING OF ASPHALT ON VARIOUS COUNTY ROADS

By Public Works Committee, Ms. McKnight and Mr. Shafer:

WHEREAS, The Albany County Department of Public Works, in cooperation with the Purchasing Agent, has solicited, reviewed and evaluated bids for material, labor and equipment necessary for the hauling and placing of asphalt on various Albany County roadways and the Department and the Purchasing Agent recommend that a contract be awarded to Callanan Industries, Inc. as the lowest of five responsible bidders, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with Callanan Industries, Inc., 1245 Kings Road, Schenectady, NY in an amount not to exceed \$1,626,499.55 as per the bid submitted regarding material, labor and equipment necessary for the hauling and placing of asphalt on various Albany County roadways at the unit cost set forth in said submitted bid including:

Asphalt Concrete, Base Course	\$40.00 per ton
Type 3 Binder Course	\$41.00 per ton
Type 6F Top Course	\$46.23 per ton
Tack Coat	\$3.00 per gal.
Cold Milling of Bituminous Concrete	\$10.00 per sq. yd.

and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
