AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH THE NYS OFFICE FOR THE AGING REGARDING THE EXPANDED IN-HOME SERVICES FOR THE ELDERLY PROGRAM (EISEP)

WHEREAS, The Commissioner of Aging has been notified by the NYS Office for the Aging that funds are available for provisions of the Expanded In-Home Services for the Elderly Program, and

WHEREAS, The Expanded In-Home Services for the Elderly Program provides attendants for home care visits of homebound elderly to tend to personal health needs and assessments, and

WHEREAS, The Commissioner has requested authorization to enter into an agreement with the NYS Office for the Aging regarding the Expanded In-Home Services for the Elderly Program commencing April 1, 2007 and ending March 31, 2008 in the amount of \$1,113,422, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with the NYS Office for the Aging in the amount of \$1,113,422 commencing April 1, 2007 and ending March 31, 2008 regarding the Expanded In-Home Services for the Elderly Program, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
