AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH THE NYS OFFICE FOR THE AGING REGARDING THE COMMUNITY SERVICES FOR THE ELDERLY PROGRAM

WHEREAS, The Commissioner of Aging has been notified by the NYS Office for the Aging that funds are available for various supportive programs, and

WHEREAS, Said program provides transportation and adult day care service programs to low income elderly persons, and

WHEREAS, The Commissioner has requested authorization to enter into an agreement with the NYS Office for the Aging in the amount of \$419,210 commencing April 1, 2007 and ending March 31, 2008 regarding various supportive programs, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with the NYS Office for the Aging in the amount of \$419,210 commencing April 1, 2007 and ending March 31, 2008 regarding various supportive programs including adult day care and transportation services, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
