

RESOLUTION NO. 214

**AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 432 FOR 2006 REGARDING A CHEMICAL
DEPENDENCY OUTPATIENT CLINIC AND AMENDING THE 2007
DEPARTMENT OF MENTAL HEALTH BUDGET**

By Health Committee and Mr. Collins:

WHEREAS, By Resolution No. 432 for 2006, this Honorable Body authorized an agreement with Pearl Street Counseling regarding a chemical dependency outpatient clinic, and

WHEREAS, The agreement provides funding for the provision of a medically supervised outpatient clinic for citizens of Albany County suffering from the symptoms or effects of alcoholism and other chemical dependencies, and

WHEREAS, The Department of Mental Health has been notified by the NYS Office of Alcoholism and Substance Abuse Services that an additional \$25,241 has been allocated to Pearl Street Counseling through Cost of Living Adjustments and other State funding, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that Resolution No. 432 for 2006 is amended to indicate that the fee corresponding to Pearl Street Counseling is changed to read \$425,844 rather than \$400,603, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the 2007 Department of Mental Health Budget is amended as follows:

Increase Revenue Account A3486 Narcotics Addiction Control by \$25,241

Increase Appropriation Account A4230.4 by \$25,241 by increasing Line Item A4230 4 4415 000 Pearl Street Counseling by \$25,241

and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
