

RESOLUTION NO. 243

AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH WILLIAM J. KELLER & SONS CONSTRUCTION CORP. REGARDING THE REHABILITATION OF CR9 OVER BRADT HOLLOW CREEK BRIDGE IN THE TOWN OF BERNE AND THE REPLACEMENT OF CR254 OVER BEAVERDAM CREEK BRIDGE IN THE TOWN OF KNOX

By Public Works Committee:

WHEREAS, The Commissioner of the Department of Public Works has requested authorization to move forward with the reconstruction of County Route 9 over Bradt Hollow Creek Bridge in the Town of Berne and the replacement of County Route 254 over Beaverdam Creek Bridge in the Town of Knox, and

WHEREAS, The Commissioner indicated that the reconstruction of County Route 9 over Bradt Hollow Creek Bridge in the Town of Berne includes the removal of the existing bridge superstructure and a portion of the abutment stem, the construction of a new prestressed concrete voided slab superstructure with an asphalt wearing surface and minor roadway approach reconstruction, substructure repair, stream bank reconstruction and guide rail installation, and

WHEREAS, The Commissioner also indicated that the County Route 254 over Beaverdam Creek Bridge in the Town of Knox includes removal of the existing pipe culvert structure and replacement with a three sided precast concrete arch, minor roadway reconstruction, stream bank reconstruction and guide rail installation, and

WHEREAS, The Department of Public Works, through the County Purchasing Agent, issued a request for bids and six bids were received pertaining to the project, the bids were reviewed and the Department of Public Works and the Purchasing Agent recommended awarding the contract to William J. Keller and Sons Construction Corp. as the lowest responsible bidder, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with William J. Keller and Sons Construction Corp., 1435 Route 9, Castleton-On-Hudson, New York 12033 in an amount not to exceed \$571,578 regarding the aforementioned project, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
