

**RESOLUTION NO. 297**

**AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 200 FOR 2007 REGARDING THE SUPPLEMENTAL NUTRITION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM AND AMENDING THE 2007 AGING DEPARTMENT BUDGET**

WHEREAS, By Resolution No. 200 for 2007, this Honorable Body authorized an agreement with the NYS Office for the Aging regarding the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program, and

WHEREAS, The Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program provides home-delivered meals to homebound seniors, nutrition counseling and case management services at various sites in Albany County, including areas of low income or minority settings, and

WHEREAS, The Commissioner of Aging has been notified by the NYS Office for the Aging that additional funds in the amount of \$82,889 have been allocated for the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program, and

WHEREAS, The aforementioned funding must be appropriated in the 2007 Department for Aging Budget, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that Resolution No. 200 for 2007 is amended to indicate that the amount of the agreement with the NYS Office for the Aging regarding the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program should read \$402,190 rather than \$361,859, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the 2007 Department for Aging Budget is amended as follows to incorporate said funding:

Increase Revenue Account A3783 Supplement Nutrition Grant by \$82,889

Increase Appropriation Account A6772.4 by \$82,889 by increasing Line Item A6772 4 4453 000 Meals on Wheels by \$82,889

and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
