WHEREAS, Albany County proposes to designate Atlas Copco Comptec, LLC manufacturing projects at 46 School Road in the Village of Voorheesville and 70 Karner Road in the Town of Colonie as a regionally significant manufacturing project in Albany County and amend the Albany County Empire Zone, and

WHEREAS, Albany County has assumed the designation of Lead Agency for the purpose of compliance with SEQR, and

WHEREAS, The Albany County Department of Economic Development, Conservation and Planning, acting on behalf of the Albany County Legislature, has reviewed the proposed action and has complied with all applicable administrative and procedural requirements on behalf of the County, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the Albany County Legislature has considered the findings of the Department of Economic Development, Conservation and Planning and has determined that the proposed action is an Unlisted Action and will not have a significant effect on the environment, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
