

RESOLUTION NO. 361

AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH HUDSON RIVER CONSTRUCTION COMPANY REGARDING THE RECONSTRUCTION OF THE BRIDGE APPROACHES ON COUNTY ROUTE 306 IN THE TOWN OF NEW SCOTLAND

By Public Works Committee, Messrs. Reilly and Domalewicz:

WHEREAS, The Commissioner of the Department of Public Works has requested authorization to move forward with the County Route 306 (Krumkill Road over Vly Creek) reconstruction of the bridge approaches project in the Town of New Scotland, and

WHEREAS, The Commissioner indicated that the County Route 306 project includes the removal of the existing approach slabs and approach pavement, excavating and disposing of the existing approach roadway embankment material, installing new geotextile separation, placing and compacting new lightweight aggregate roadway embankment material, casting new lightweight reinforced concrete approach slabs, and placing new approach pavement courses, and

WHEREAS, The Department of Public Works, through the County Purchasing Agent, issued a request for bids and on July 12, 2007 two bids were received, and

WHEREAS, The Department of Public Works engineering staff reviewed said bids and recommended awarding the contract to Hudson River Construction Company as the lowest responsible bidder, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with Hudson River Construction Company, Port of Albany, Albany, New York 12202 in an amount not to exceed \$110,745 regarding the County Route 306 reconstruction project in the Town of New Scotland, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
