

**RESOLUTION NO. 423**

**URGING THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE TO ASSIGN A GUILDERLAND ZIP CODE TO AN AREA OF THE TOWN OF GUILDERLAND PRESENTLY INCLUDED IN A SCHENECTADY ZIP CODE**

WHEREAS, An area in the northwest portion of the Town of Guilderland, Albany County is presently included by the United States Postal Service in three separate zip codes (12303, 12304 and 12306) which are designated Schenectady, and

WHEREAS, The designation of Schenectady zip codes in this area of the Town of Guilderland and the County of Albany by the Postal Service creates confusion for those residence since this area is not within either the City or County of Schenectady, and

WHEREAS, The resident's whom are effected by this postal code confusion requires driving across County lines to pick up packages and their mail, clearly causing an inconvenience, and

WHEREAS, This has been an ongoing issue plaguing the resident's within the 12303, 12304, and 12306 zip code areas and it is time for the United State Postal Service to rectify the situation, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that it hereby requests the United States Postal Service to provide new zip codes to that area of the Town of Guilderland and County of Albany which are currently assigned Schenectady zip codes, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the Postmaster General, the Board of Governors of the United States Postal Service, United States Congressman Michael McNulty, United States Senator Hillary Clinton, United States Senator Charles Schumer and to the appropriate County Officials.
