

RESOLUTION NO. 455

AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH BI, INC. REGARDING GPS ELECTRONIC MONITORING OF SEX OFFENDERS

By Public Safety Committee:

WHEREAS, By Resolution No. 202 for 2005, this Honorable Body requested County officials to strengthen efforts to protect children and others from sexual predators, including the possibility of initiating electronic tracking of designated sex offenders convicted of violent crimes and those deemed to be at a high risk of re-offending, and

WHEREAS, The Probation Department through the County Purchasing Agent issued a request for proposals and four bids were received regarding electronic monitoring services for sex offenders, and

WHEREAS, The Probation Department reviewed said proposals and recommended awarding the contract to BI, Inc. as the lowest responsible bidder to provide and maintain GPS electronic monitoring services for probation-sentenced sex offenders determined to be at high risk to re-offend in an amount not to exceed \$224.18 per probationer per month, up to a maximum of \$108,000 over a two-year period commencing December 1, 2007 and ending November 30, 2009, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with BI, Inc., 6400 Lookout Road, Boulder, CO 80301 regarding GPS electronic monitoring of sex offenders in an amount not to exceed \$224.18 per probationer per month, up to a maximum of \$108,000 over a two-year period commencing December 1, 2007 and ending November 30, 2009, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
