

**RESOLUTION NO. 22**

**AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION AND AN AGREEMENT WITH THE NYS DIVISION OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE SERVICES REGARDING RECRUITMENT AND RETENTION FUNDING AND AMENDING THE 2008 DISTRICT ATTORNEY'S BUDGET**

WHEREAS, The NYS Division of Criminal Justice Services has notified the District Attorney's Office that grant funding in the amount of \$40,133 is available to assist in the recruitment and retention of Assistant District Attorneys, and

WHEREAS, The District Attorney' Office has requested authorization to submit a grant application and enter into a two year agreement with the NYS Division of Criminal Justice Services in the amount of \$40,133 commencing April 1, 2007 through March 31, 2009 regarding the recruitment and retention of Assistant District Attorneys, and

WHEREAS, The District Attorney's Office has also requested a budget amendment in order to incorporate the aforementioned funding, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to submit a grant application to the NYS Division of Criminal Justice Services regarding funding for the recruitment and retention of Assistant District Attorneys, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Executive is authorized to enter into a two year agreement with the NYS Division of Criminal Justice Services in the amount of \$40,133 for the period commencing April 1, 2007 through March 31, 2009 regarding the Recruitment and Retention Program for Assistant District Attorneys, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the aforementioned funds shall be paid in December 2008 at amounts as finalized by the District Attorney's Office, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the 2008 District Attorney's Budget is amended as follows:

Increase Revenue Account A1165 3002 Retention Grant by \$40,133

Increase Appropriation Account A1165.1 by \$40,133 by increasing Line Item A1165 1 9953 000 Retention Longevity by \$40,133

and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said grant application and agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
