AUTHORIZING AGREEMENTS WITH THE NYS OFFICE OF CHILDREN AND FAMILY SERVICES AND THE CAPITAL DISTRICT CHILD CARE COORDINATING COUNCIL REGARDING FAMILY DAY CARE REGISTRATION AND INSPECTION SERVICES

By Social Services Committee:

WHEREAS, The NYS Office of Children and Family Services has provided 100% State funding to contract for the processing of day care registration applications and inspections of registered providers, and

WHEREAS, The Commissioner of the Department of Social Services has requested authorization to enter into an agreement with the NYS Office of Children and Family Services regarding Family Day Care Registration and Inspection Services, commencing January 1, 2008 and ending December 31, 2008, in an amount not to exceed \$233,471, and

WHEREAS, The Commissioner has also requested authorization to enter into the fourth year of a multi-year agreement with the Capital District Child Care Coordinating Council for payment through the NYS Office of Children and Family Services commencing January 1, 2008 and ending December 31, 2008, in an amount not to exceed \$223,667, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement for funding with the NYS Office of Children and Family Services, commencing January 1, 2008 and ending December 31, 2008, in an amount not to exceed \$233,471, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Executive is authorized to enter into the fourth year of a multi-year agreement with the Capital District Child Care Coordinating Council commencing January 1, 2008 and ending December 31, 2008, in an amount not to exceed \$223,667, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreements as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
