AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH THE NYS GOVERNOR'S TRAFFIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REGARDING A BUCKLE UP NEW YORK GRANT

By Public Safety Committee:

WHEREAS, The NYS Governor's Traffic Safety Committee has informed the Albany County Sheriff that funds are available for a Buckle Up New York Grant in the amount of \$50,636 for the period October 1, 2007 to September 30, 2008, and

WHEREAS, The Sheriff indicated that the funding will allow the Albany County Traffic Safety Board and participating agencies in Albany County to participate in the Buckle Up New York campaign, targeting occupant restraint and non-compliance, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with the NYS Governor's Traffic Safety Committee regarding a Buckle Up New York Grant for the period October 1, 2007 to September 30, 2008 in the amount of \$50,636, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
