**AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE
NYS DIVISION OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE SERVICES REGARDING
OPERATION IMPACT FUNDING**

By Law Committee, Mr. Cotrofeld, Mss. McKnight and Maffia-Tobler:

WHEREAS, The District Attorney's Office has indicated that grant funding is available to Albany County through the NYS Division of Criminal Justice Services regarding Operation IMPACT, and

WHEREAS, The State aid will be directed to improve crime enforcement strategies and responses to targeted drug and handgun crimes in designated areas within Albany County, and

WHEREAS, It was indicated that the IMPACT grant will continue funding the positions of two assistant district attorneys to focus on prosecutions resulting from Operation IMPACT arrests, anti-gang and anti-gun programs and a Technical Support Services Consultant to design an interface between the DA's Office and the Albany Police Department to improve data sharing and communications, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to submit a grant application to the NYS Division of Criminal Justice Services pertaining to Operation IMPACT funding, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said grant application as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
