**AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT REGARDING THE ORGANIZED CRIME
DRUG ENFORCEMENT TASK FORCE AND AMENDING THE 2008
SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT BUDGET**

By Public Safety Committee, Messrs. Domalewicz, Scavo and Cotrofeld:

WHEREAS, The County Sheriff has indicated that reimbursement for overtime in the amount of \$10,000 is available through the U.S. Department of Justice, United States Attorney Organized Crime Drug Enforcement Task Force regarding the Project "Safe Streets" initiative, and

WHEREAS, Project "Safe Streets" is a coordinated effort by Federal, City and County law enforcement agencies to target street robberies and conduct warrant and probation sweeps throughout the County of Albany, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with the U.S. Department of Justice, United States Attorney Organized Crime Drug Enforcement Task Force, regarding reimbursement in the amount of \$10,000 for overtime incurred by members of the Sheriff's Department for their participation in the "Safe Streets" initiative, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the 2008 Sheriff's Department Budget is amended as follows:

Increase Revenue Account 4323 Reimb. Crime Drug Enforcement by \$10,000

Increase Appropriation Account A3110.1 by \$10,000 by increasing Line Item A3110 1 9900 000 Overtime by \$10,000

and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
