WHEREAS, The Commissioner of the Department of Public Works has requested approval to submit a grant application for up to \$400,000 to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency regarding clean diesel retrofit and replacement funding for public works vehicles, and

WHEREAS, The Commissioner indicated that the EPA grants will pay 100% of the diesel retrofit costs and 25% of the vehicle replacement costs for both on-road and off-road diesel vehicles, and

WHEREAS, The Commissioner further indicated that the Department would receive credit for in-kind work performed by its mechanics to install the diesel retrofit equipment, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to submit a grant application for funding up to \$400,000 to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency regarding clean diesel retrofit and replacement funding for public works vehicles, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said grant application as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
