

RESOLUTION NO. 210

AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH POLYDYNE, INC. TO SUPPLY THE SEWER DISTRICT WITH LIQUID POLYMER

By Public Works Committee:

WHEREAS, By Resolution No. 132 for 2006, the Albany County Legislature authorized an agreement with Polydyne, Inc. to supply liquid polymer to the Albany County Sewer District, and

WHEREAS, The agreement called for Polydyne, Inc. to provide and deliver liquid polymer, used in the solids handling dewatering facilities at the North and South Plants, at a cost of \$0.079 per pound, for the 2007 and 2008 calendar years with an option to extend the agreement for one year at the same price, and

WHEREAS, The Executive Director of the Sewer District has indicated that it is in the County's best interests to extend the current agreement because of rising transportation costs and has requested legislative authorization for the agreement through 2009, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an extension of the agreement with Polydyne, Inc., P.O. Box 279, Riceboro, Georgia for the provision of delivered liquid polymer at a cost of \$0.079 per pound for the period January 1, 2009 to December 31, 2009, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
