

RESOLUTION NO. 236

AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH THE NYS CRIME VICTIMS BOARD REGARDING A MEDIA AWARENESS CAMPAIGN PERTAINING TO SEXUAL ASSAULT VICTIM SERVICES AND AMENDING THE 2008 CRIME VICTIM AND SEXUAL VIOLENCE CENTER BUDGET

By Law Committee, Messrs. Domalewicz, Nichols and Cotrofeld:

WHEREAS, The Crime Victim and Sexual Violence Center has been advised by the New York State Crime Victims Board that \$44,200 is available to Albany County regarding a multi-media awareness campaign pertaining to sexual assault victim services, and

WHEREAS, Said grant funding is allocated to support public information and media projects which increase awareness of sexual assault by advertising on CDTA buses and shelters as well as creating two radio and television public access service announcements, and

WHEREAS, The Director of the Crime Victim and Sexual Violence Center has requested authorization to enter into an agreement with the New York State Crime Victims Board in the amount of \$44,200 commencing July 15, 2008 and ending July 14, 2009, and

WHEREAS, The Director has also requested a budget amendment for the aforementioned expenditures now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with the New York State Crime Victims Board in the amount of \$44,200 commencing July 15, 2008 and ending July 14, 2009 regarding a multi-media awareness campaign pertaining to sexual assault victim services, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the 2008 Crime Victim and Sexual Violence Center Budget is amended as follows:

Increase Revenue Account A3496 Victims Assistance Grant by \$44,200

Increase Appropriation Account A4610.4 by \$44,200 by increasing Line Item A4610 4 4042 000 Printing And Advertising by \$44,200

and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
