

RESOLUTION NO. 491

APPOINTMENT OF AN ELECTION COMMISSIONER FOR A TWO YEAR TERM

WHEREAS, In accordance with Section 3-202 of the New York State Election Law, this Honorable Body may determine that the term of office of the Election Commissioners be for a period of two years, and

WHEREAS, The Clerk of the Albany County Legislature has received a Certificate from the Albany County Democratic Committee recommending Matthew J. Clyne, a qualified voter of the County of Albany and a fit and proper person, be appointed as Democratic Commissioner of Elections in accordance with the provisions of Section 3-204 of the Election Law, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By this Honorable Body, pursuant to the provisions of Section 3-204 of the Election Law, that Matthew J. Clyne be and hereby is appointed as Election Commissioner of the County of Albany for a term commencing January 1, 2009 and ending December 31, 2010, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Albany County Legislature considers the County's two Election Commissioners to be full-time employees as stated in Resolution No. 58 for 2005 raising the Commissioners' salaries from \$33,661 to \$65,000 a year and by Resolution No. 460 for 2006 adopting the 2007 Albany County Budget with a salary increase to \$80,000 a year, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That as a condition of appointment, the Legislature directs the Election Commissioner to abide by the attendance rules outlined in Article II of the Rules and Regulations for Albany County Employees requiring the recording of arrival and departure times from the work site, which is accomplished through the Kronos timekeeping system, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
