

RESOLUTION NO. 268

AUTHORIZING THE ALBANY COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS TO CERTIFY ITS EXPENSES FOR 2008 AND TO FURTHER CERTIFY WHICH EXPENSES ARE TO BE BORNE BY MUNICIPALITIES LOCATED IN THE COUNTY OF ALBANY

WHEREAS, Section 4-138 of New York State Election Law provides for County legislatures to direct County Boards of Election to certify total expenses of said boards, and

WHEREAS, Section 4-138 further states "... if the legislative body of any county shall so direct..." the Board of Elections shall certify the portions of such expenses which are "...to be borne by any city or cities in said county, and the portion thereof which is to be borne by the rest of such county.", now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, The Albany County Legislature authorizes and directs the Albany County Board of Elections to certify the expenses to be borne by any city or cities in Albany County as outline by Section 4-138 of New York State Election Law, and, be it further

RESOLVED, To the extent not already accomplished, the Albany County Legislature authorizes and directs the Albany County Board of Elections to certify such expenses for the years 2006 and 2007, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Albany County Board of Elections is hereby directed to certify such expenses annually in accordance with costs associated for each future elections held, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the Legislature is hereby directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
