

## RESOLUTION NO. 27

### **DETERMINATION THAT THE PROPOSED PURCHASE OF THE PARKING LOT LOCATED AT 208 WASHINGTON AVENUE WILL NOT HAVE A SIGNIFICANT EFFECT ON THE ENVIRONMENT**

By Social Services and Audit and Finance Committees:

WHEREAS, Albany County proposes to renew its existing lease and subsequently purchase the surface parking lot located at 208 Washington Avenue in the City of Albany for continued use by County employees who work at 162 Washington Avenue, and

WHEREAS, The purchase is subject to the requirements of State Environmental Quality Review (SEQR) pursuant to 6 NYCRR Part 617, and

WHEREAS, Albany County has assumed the designation of Lead Agency for the purpose of compliance with SEQR, and

WHEREAS, The Albany County Department of Economic Development, Conservation and Planning, acting on behalf of the Albany County Legislature, has reviewed the proposed action and has complied with all applicable administrative and procedural requirements on behalf of the County, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the Albany County Legislature has considered the findings of the Department of Economic Development, Conservation and Planning and has determined that the proposed purchase is an Unlisted Action and will not have a significant effect on the environment, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
