AUTHORIZING AGREEMENTS WITH THE TOWN OF NEW SCOTLAND, DELMAR FIRE DISTRICT AND BETHLEHEM VOLUNTEER AMBULANCE REGARDING EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIANS - DEFIBRILLATION (EMT-D)

WHEREAS, The Albany County Sheriff has requested authorization to enter into agreements with the Town of New Scotland, Delmar Fire District and Bethlehem Volunteer Ambulance to provide Emergency Medical Technician-Defibrillation (EMT-D) through the County's Emergency Medical Services Program, and

WHEREAS, Albany County will provide the Town of New Scotland with EMT-D coverage for one 12-hour shift Monday through Friday; the Delmar Fire District with coverage for four 12-hour shifts Monday through Friday plus two 12-hour shifts on weekends; and Bethlehem Volunteer Ambulance with coverage for two 12-hour shifts seven days a week, and in return the three governmental entities will reimburse the County for said services, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into agreements with the Town of New Scotland, the Delmar Fire District and Bethlehem Volunteer Ambulance for the period January 1, 2009 through December 31, 2009 regarding Emergency Medical Technicians – Defibrillation (EMT-D), and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the agreement with the Town of New Scotland shall be in the amount of \$52,655.47, with the Delmar Fire District in the amount of \$252,746.23, and with Bethlehem Volunteer Ambulance in the amount of \$147,435.30, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreements as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
