

RESOLUTION NO. 56

DETERMINATION THAT THE REHABILITATION OF CR154 (OSBORNE ROAD) IN THE TOWN OF COLONIE WILL NOT HAVE A SIGNIFICANT EFFECT ON THE ENVIRONMENT

WHEREAS, Albany County proposes to rehabilitate approximately 1.9 miles of CR154 (Osborne Road) from State Route 5 (Central Avenue) to CR 151 (Albany Shaker Road), and to install new sidewalks, acquire an eight-foot wide strip along approximately one mile of the existing right-of-way to accommodate the sidewalk, and improve the existing drainage system with replacement or repair of catch basins and drainage pipes as necessary, and

WHEREAS, The proposed action is subject to the requirements of State Environmental Quality Review (SEQR) pursuant to 6 NYCRR 617, and

WHEREAS, Albany County has assumed the designation of Lead Agency for the purpose of compliance with SEQR for this unlisted action, and

WHEREAS, The Albany County Department of Economic Development, Conservation and Planning, acting on behalf of the Albany County Legislature has reviewed the proposed action and has complied with all applicable administrative and procedural requirements on behalf of the County, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the Albany County Legislature has considered the findings of the Department of Economic Development, Conservation and Planning and has determined that the proposed action will not have a significant effect on the environment, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
