

RESOLUTION NO. 100

AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 419 FOR 2008: CONFIRMING THE SALE OF 219 COLONIE STREET AND 332 THIRD STREET IN THE CITY OF ALBANY SOLD AT THE OCTOBER 18, 2008 PUBLIC AUCTION TO THE RECORDED BACKUP BIDDER

WHEREAS, By Resolution No. 419 for 2008, this Honorable Body authorized the sale of two parcels of property at 219 Colonie Street and 332 Third Street in the City of Albany, acquired through in rem foreclosure for unpaid taxes, to the highest bidder at the October 18, 2008 public auction, and

WHEREAS, The Commissioner of the Department of Management and Budget has reported that the winning bidder failed to close on the properties and requests that the Legislature approve conveyance to the backup bidder, and

WHEREAS, Revisions to the County's Real Property Disposition Plan approved by Resolution No. 111 for 2002 implemented procedures for properties under certain circumstances to be sold to recorded backup bidders, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that Resolution No. 419 for 2008 is amended by repealing authorization for the sale of Parcel 26 at 219 Colonie Street in the City of Albany to Lawrence Cassella for \$1,000 and instead approving the conveyance of the property to Robert Keyes as the backup bidder for \$500, contingent upon compliance with terms of the sale, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That Resolution No. 419 for 2008 is further amended by repealing authorization for the sale of Parcel 111 at 332 Third Street in the City of Albany to Lawrence Cassella for \$500 and instead approving the conveyance of the property to Robert Keyes as the backup bidder for \$500, contingent upon compliance with the terms of the sale, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said conveyance as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
