

## RESOLUTION NO. 122

### **AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH GREENMAN-PEDERSEN, INC. REGARDING CONSTRUCTION INSPECTION SERVICES FOR THE CR 156 FULLER ROAD CORRIDOR IMPROVEMENT PROJECT IN THE CITY OF ALBANY AND THE TOWNS OF GUILDERLAND AND COLONIE**

WHEREAS, By Resolution No. 459 for 2006, this Honorable Body authorized funding regarding the County Route 156 Fuller Road Corridor Improvement Project in the City of Albany and the Towns of Guilderland and Colonie, and

WHEREAS, The Commissioner of the Department of Public Works has requested authorization to move forward with the construction inspection services for the County Route 156 Fuller Road Corridor Improvement Project in the City of Albany and the Towns of Guilderland and Colonie, and

WHEREAS, The Department of Public Works through the County Purchasing Agent issued a request for proposals and on February 19, 2009 seven proposals were received pertaining to the project, and

WHEREAS, The Department of Public Works engineering staff reviewed said bids and recommended awarding the contract to Greenman-Pedersen, Inc. as offering the best value for Albany County, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with Greenman-Pedersen, Inc., 43 Fuller Road, Albany, New York in an amount not to exceed \$825,000 regarding construction inspection services for the County Route 156 Fuller Road Corridor Improvement Project in the City of Albany and the Towns of Guilderland and Colonie, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
