

**RESOLUTION NO. 148**

**DETERMINATION THAT THE PROPOSED SEWER DISTRICT'S EFFLUENT DISINFECTION PROJECT WILL NOT HAVE A SIGNIFICANT EFFECT ON THE ENVIRONMENT**

By Public Works Committee, Ms. McKnight and Mr. Scavo:

WHEREAS, The Albany County Sewer District proposes to install various equipment necessary to implement the disinfection of coliform/pathogens in the North and South Plant Effluent Project as mandated under modifications to the Sewer District's SPDES permit, and

WHEREAS, The proposed work is subject to the requirements of State Environmental Quality Review (SEQR) pursuant to 6 NYCRR Part 617, and

WHEREAS, Albany County has assumed the designation of Lead Agency for the purpose of compliance with SEQR, and

WHEREAS, The Albany County Department of Economic Development, Conservation and Planning, acting on behalf of the Albany County Legislature, has reviewed the proposed action and has complied with all applicable administrative and procedural requirements on behalf of the County, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the Albany County Legislature has considered the findings of the Department of Economic Development, Conservation and Planning and has determined that the proposed Effluent Disinfection Project is a Type II action and will not have a significant effect on the environment, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That no other determinations or procedures are required with respect to this proposed project in accordance with the requirements set forth in the applicable administrative and procedural requirements of SEQR, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
