

RESOLUTION NO. 187

AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH THE TOWN OF COLONIE REGARDING DISPOSAL OF ASH AT THE LANDFILL

Introduced: 6/8/09

By Public Works Committee:

WHEREAS, The Executive Director of the Albany County Sewer District has requested authorization to enter into an agreement with the Town of Colonie regarding the disposal of incinerator ash produced by the North and South Plant incineration / solids handling operations, and

WHEREAS, The Sewer District, after an extensive review of available alternatives for the disposal of ash, has determined that the most feasible alternative is to dispose of the ash at the Town of Colonie Landfill, and

WHEREAS, The Executive Director indicated that the agreement with the Town of Colonie is for one year with four one year extensions in an amount not to exceed \$27,000 per year, and

WHEREAS, The Executive Director also indicated that the Sewer District will continue to be proactive in researching and pursuing additional alternatives of beneficial use of the sewer sludge ash, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into a one year agreement with four one year extensions between the Albany County Sewer District and the Town of Colonie in an amount not to exceed \$27,000 per year regarding disposal of ash produced by the North and South Plant incineration / solids handling operations, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is hereby authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
