

RESOLUTION NO. 287

AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT REGARDING THE PURCHASE OF SIGNS FOR THE KRUMKILL ROAD/SCHOOLHOUSE ROAD INTERSECTION IN THE TOWN OF BETHLEHEM AND AMENDING THE 2009 PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT BUDGET

By Public Works Committee, Messrs. Domalewicz and McCoy:

WHEREAS, The Department of Public Works has requested authorization to enter into an agreement with the NYS Department of State regarding funding to purchase three welcome signs from a local sign fabricator for the Krumkill Road/Schoolhouse Road intersection in the Town of Bethlehem, and

WHEREAS, The Commissioner indicated that the signs will be purchased using NYS Legislative Initiative Funds and that County employees and equipment will be used to install the signs and plant small shrubs on County property inside the roundabout on the Krumkill Road/Schoolhouse Road intersection in the Town of Bethlehem, and

WHEREAS, The Commissioner also requested a budget amendment in the amount of \$5,000 in order to meet said expenditures, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with the NYS Department of State in an amount not to exceed \$5,000 regarding funding to purchase three welcome signs for the Krumkill Road/Schoolhouse Road intersection in the Town of Bethlehem, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the 2009 Department of Public Works Budget is amended as follows:

Increase Revenue Account D3591 Highway Capital Project by \$5,000

Increase Appropriation Account D5112.4 by \$5,000 by increasing Line Item D5112 4 4075 Bridge And Road Repair by \$5,000

and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
