WHEREAS, It is anticipated that additional stimulus monies may become available to Albany County, and

WHEREAS, As the appropriating and policy determining body of the County, it is most appropriate that the County Legislature be involved in the decision making concerning how and where the County may seek to utilize future stimulus funding, and

WHEREAS, In order to afford the County Legislature meaningful input relevant to the application for and utilization of stimulus monies it is important that each County department which is proposing to seek stimulus funding to be used for County purposes advise the Legislature of its intent to seek stimulus funding and detail the purposes for which the funding will be utilized, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, By this Honorable Body that each County department which is proposing to seek stimulus funding to be used for County purposes shall prior to submitting any application for stimulus funding advise the Legislature of its intent to seek stimulus funding and detail the purposes for which the funding will be utilized by submitting such information for approval of both the Audit and Finance Committee and the appropriate legislative standing committee, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
