

RESOLUTION NO. 452

DETERMINATION THAT THE PROPOSED REHABILITATION OF CR203 (JOHNSTON ROAD) IN THE TOWNS OF GUILDERLAND AND NEW SCOTLAND WILL NOT HAVE A SIGNIFICANT EFFECT ON THE ENVIRONMENT

By Audit and Finance Committee and Mr. Reilly:

WHEREAS, Albany County proposes to rehabilitate approximately 5.2 miles of CR203 (Johnston Road) between State Route 20 (Western Avenue) in the Town of Guilderland and State Route 155 (State Farm Road) in the Town of New Scotland, with the possibility of widening a travel lane from 11 to 14 feet to accommodate shared bicycle use, and to make ancillary improvements such as installing underdrains, sidewalks, curbs, guide rails and a new closed drainage system and modifying existing water and sewer lines, and

WHEREAS, The proposed action is subject to the requirements of State Environmental Quality Review (SEQR) pursuant to 6 NYCRR 617, and

WHEREAS, Albany County has assumed the designation of Lead Agency for the purpose of compliance with SEQR for this unlisted action, and

WHEREAS, The Albany County Department of Economic Development, Conservation and Planning, acting on behalf of the Albany County Legislature has reviewed the proposed action and has complied with all applicable administrative and procedural requirements on behalf of the County, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the Albany County Legislature has considered the findings of the Department of Economic Development, Conservation and Planning and has determined that the proposed action will not have a significant effect on the environment, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
