This State of Emergency has been declared due to the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) outbreak which is now a pandemic public health emergency of international concern and threatens the health and welfare of the citizens of Albany County.

This State of Emergency will remain in effect until rescinded by a subsequent order.

As the Executive of Albany County, I, Daniel P. McCoy exercise the authority given me under §24 of the New York State Executive Law, to preserve the public safety and hereby render all required and available assistance vital to the security, well-being, and health of the citizens of Albany County.

I hereby direct all departments and agencies of Albany County to take whatever steps necessary to protect life and property, public infrastructure, and provide such emergency assistance deemed necessary.
